**CONDUCT OF ATHLETIC PROGRAMS**

**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this policy is to establish School Committee standards and guidelines in regards to the District's efforts to carry out an appropriate program of quality and success in regards to athletic activities for the students of the District.

**PHILOSOPHY:**

The School Committee believes that in order for students to achieve a full, satisfying and well-rounded education, they should be exposed to school sponsored activities outside the regular academic environment of the school.

**POLICY STATEMENT:**

After school programs athletic in nature, and those authorized as established extra-curricular activities, shall be made available to the students of the school district in keeping with provisions as set forth and provided for within the District's budget for each school year.

**PARTICIPATION IN ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES:**

1. No students may enter any formal athletic program sponsored by the District, not practice for such a program, until he/she undergoes a physical examination, has been granted permission by the school physician, and is covered by the basic student insurance or school insurance waiver form, plus any additional insurance that may be required for a specific sport, such as football.

**USE OF SCHOOL ATHLETIC EQUIPMENT:**

1. The assignment of any and all athletic equipment and uniforms is to proceed from the athletic director to the head coach in accordance with all rules of the Rhode Island Interscholastic League.
2. The use of any District equipment and uniforms is approved for use only during dates prescribed by league rules and

only during practices, games and/or scrimmages directly supervised by the Foster-Glocester Regional Coaching Staff.

3. Each coach will receive a copy of this policy upon notification of appointment by the Foster-Glocester Regional School Committee.

AWARDS FOR CHAMPIONSHIP TEAMS:

In the event any Ponaganset Regional School Team is awarded a championship plaque by the R.I.A.S.P. Committee on Athletics, the School Committee shall:

1. Provide the appropriate banner for display in the gymnasium
2. Provide each member of the winning team (including coaches and volunteers) the standard picture-plaque.
3. Provide the school with an additional plaque for display in the building
4. Recognize any individual student who has been designated as First Team All-State with their name, sport and year on a plaque in the school's lobby.
