LOW ENROLLMENT CLASSES

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy shall be to set forth the expectations of the School Committee in handling the scheduling of classes in the event that the number of students signed up for a particular class fails to exceed ten (10) in number, exclusive of special and otherwise authorized programs.

POLICY STATEMENT:

1. The Principal shall inform the Superintendent of enrollment of ten or less at the time of registration for the following year's courses. Classes with fewer than ten enrollees may not be offered. However, after consultation with the Principal, the Superintendent may recommend to the School Committee that such courses be offered due to their content or uniqueness (for example, and Advanced Placement course).
2. Subsequently, the Principal shall notify the Superintendent on a monthly basis if enrollment in a course drops to ten.
3. In the event that the enrollment of any class (with the exception of special programs) drops below ten (10) students, the Principal shall call this fact to the attention of the Superintendent who shall inform the School Committee at its next regularly scheduled meeting.
