MISSING CHILDREN RECORDS FILE

PURPOSE:

This directive is written in support of the Rhode Island General Law, Section 42-28.8-8 regarding missing children. The following specifies the procedure to ensure that any new student entering our schools is screened to be certain that they are not a missing child.

POLICY STATEMENT:

Each school shall set up a missing children folder. Enclosed within the folder will be all lists of missing children sent by the police or the State Department of Education since the program began.

Whenever a new student enrolls in our schools, the building principal will check the missing children's folder to determine if the enrolling student is on the missing list. If the name is on the list, the principal will immediately contact the designee at the State Police Headquarters at 647-3311 to pass along any pertinent information.
