SPECIAL EDUCATION STUDENTS

PURPOSE:

To establish School Committee expectations in regards to student entrance into the regional School District as eligible enrollees in consideration of State Regulation.

PHILOSOPHY:

The School Committee recognizes State requirements and expectations in regards to the identification of special needs students, and notes its support and endorsement of the special considerations essential to the fulfillment of the needs of students so identified. In consideration thereof, the Committee establishes guidelines as follows in determining a student's eligibility to enter the Regional District as a resident student.

POLICY STATEMENT:

Any student who is a resident of Foster or Glocester, and has been designated as a special needs student, shall become a regional financial responsibility at the beginning of the school year under any of the following conditions:

1. The student becomes twelve years of age on or before December 31 of the school year.
2. The student attends a self-contained class.
3. The student is a tuition student.
