## STUDENT VEHICLES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

## PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to set forth School Committee expectation in regard to the rights and responsibilities of students to drive privately owned vehicles to and from school and on school property, and to set forth the authority of the school administration to oversee student conduct in this regard.

## PHILOSOPHY:

The School Committee acknowledges its responsibility to provide transportation to students whose residence exceeds limits as specified in State Law, and commits to the fulfillment of these legal obligations. However, the Committee also recognizes and endorses the right of appropriate aged students who may wish to do so, to travel to and from school in privately owned vehicles as approved by their parent(s) or guardian. The Committee believes, however, that the driving of a private vehicle to and from school and on school property is a privilege which must not be abused. In consideration thereof, the Committee sets forth this policy statement.

## POLICY STATEMENT:

Driving vehicles on to school grounds is a student privilege which can and will be revoked for violation of either school committee policy or administrative regulations. The high school administration will establish procedures for registration of student vehicles and administration of appropriate procedures for revoking this privilege. In any event, students need to show proof of current automobile insurance before registering their automobile.
