TUITION FOR OUT OF DISTRICT STUDENTS

PURPOSE:

To establish conditions by which the school committee will accept out of town students as tuition students.

PHILOSOPHY:

The Foster-Glocester Regional School Committee recognizes that from time to time requests from individuals or school systems to have students attend our schools on a tuition basis are received by the administration.

POLICY STATEMENT:

The Foster-Glocester Regional School Committee will only accept requests to accept students on a tuition basis from school systems that are members in the Northwest Special Education Collaborative Region. They will not accept any requests from non-resident parents or guardians in behalf of their children.

TUITION STUDENTS - ADMISSION

Students admitted to the Foster-Glocester School District as tuition students are not considered officially enrolled until such admission has been recommended by the Principal and approved by the Superintendent and School Committee.

Tuition rates for non-resident pupils attending Foster-Glocester Regional Schools will be the same as the per pupil current expenditure cost of education (as found in Form 31 of the State Department of Education Annual Report) for the school year immediately preceding.

WAIVER OF TUITION:

Tuition for students whose parents are planning to establish residence in Foster or Glocester will be waived if the family is officially in residence prior to the end of the first school quarter. The school Attendance Officer must verify compliance with this policy. If parents are unable to move into their homes prior to the deadline date, they must pay tuition for each student enrolled in the district schools retroactive to their first day of attendance.

PAYMENT OF TUITION COSTS FOR RESIDENT STUDENTS TO ATTEND CLASSES
OUTSIDE THE DISTRICT:

The School Committee will not assume the cost of tuition payments and/or transportation costs for resident students to attend schools outside the School District except as required by law.
